Nearly 5 Million L.A. County Voters Have the Opportunity to Cast Their Ballot

The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan encourages nearly 5 million voters to cast their vote tomorrow for the Nov. 4, 2014 General Election. More than 406,000 voters have already cast their ballot by mail.
