Last Day to Request a Vote by Mail Ballot for the March 3 Presidential Primary Election

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan reminds eligible voters that the deadline to request a Vote by Mail ballot is **tonight at 11:59 PM**.

As of today, the RR/CC has issued **3,536,844** Vote by Mail ballots. Voters can request a Vote by Mail ballot by:

- Applying online at lavote.net
- Returning the application on the back of the Sample Ballot
- Requesting a Vote by Mail ballot in person at the RR/CC headquarters: <u>12400 Imperial Highway</u>, 3rd Floor (Room 3002), Norwalk CA 90650

The Vote by Mail materials are easier to read, easier to understand, easier to fill out and easier to return – and, no postage is required to return the ballot.

Voters can track the status of their returned ballot online at lavote.net.

There are **206 drop-off locations** throughout the County for voters to securely drop off their ballot inperson. Find your nearest <u>VBM drop-off location</u>.

Please note all VBM ballots postmarked by Election Day will be counted if received within three (3) days by the by the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (E.C. § 3020).
