## Vote by Mail Ballots Mailed for the March 3 Presidential Primary Election

LOS ANGELES – The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) began mailing **3,430,940** Vote by Mail (VBM) ballots for the March 3 Presidential Primary Election.

Request a VBM ballot <u>online</u> or by filling out and returning the VBM application on the back side of the Sample Ballot. Voters who return their ballot by mail are not required to include postage on the return envelope.

Voters who prefer to drop off their ballot in-person can visit any of the 206 Vote by Mail Drop-off locations throughout the County – a significant expansion from 2016 and 2018. Hours of these locations will vary, view the <u>Vote by Mail Drop-off page</u> for additional information. Voters may also drop off their ballot at any Vote Center in the County starting Saturday, February 22.

Track the status of your ballot online with the <u>VBM status tool</u>.

Starting today, any voter can visit our <u>Norwalk</u> Headquarters on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor and vote early on the new Ballot Marking Devices or on a Vote by Mail ballot.
