First Election Results Update for the Congressional District 34 Special Primary Election

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the first ballot counting update for the Congressional District 34 Special Primary Election.

The update includes **11,506** ballots processed since Election Night, consisting of Vote by Mail and provisional ballots. The total election results count is now **40,913**, which is **13.42%** of eligible Los Angeles County voters.
