First Ballot Counting Update for the Congressional District 25 Special General Election

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the first ballot counting update for the Congressional District 25 Special General Election.

The update includes **26,019** Vote by Mail ballots processed since Election Night. The total election results count is now **133,838**, which is **37.99%** of eligible Los Angeles County voters.

These results are subject to change throughout the [Official Election Canvass](#) period as our canvass staff process outstanding ballots.

An estimated number of outstanding ballots left to be counted is **1,285**.

- **Vote by Mail ballots***: 780
- **Conditional Voter Registration ballots**: 220
- **Provisional ballots**: 85
- **Misc. ballots****: 200
