Second Ballot Counting Update for the Congressional District 25 Special General Election

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the second ballot counting update for the Congressional District 25 Special General Election.

The update includes **469** Vote by Mail and Vote Center ballots processed since Election Night. The total election results count is now **134,307**, which is **38.13**% of eligible Los Angeles County voters.

These results are subject to change throughout the <u>Official Election Canvass</u> period as our canvass staff process outstanding ballots.

An estimated number of outstanding ballots left to be counted is 950.
